Lesson Plan #2 - Global

Title: My Birthday Connection

Objectives: In this lesson students will: 1. learn about famous women of history

- 2. practice researching information on the Internet
- 3. present orally their findings to a group of peers

Session Time: 30 – 60 minutes

Materials: Internet connection with access to this website:

http://womenshistory.about.com/library/cal/bl00.htm

or printed material on famous women born on dates of students from class

Procedure:

- 1. Begin a general discussion on women who have made an impact on the world.
- 2. Ask students to research women with whom they share a birth date by using the website: http://womenshistory.about.com/library/cal/bl00.htm
- 3. If there is no one of interest to them on their birthday, ask them to choose a different day (child's birthday, important date, etc.)
- 4. Ask students to report to the class using the worksheet for a guide if desired. Use visuals if possible.
- 5. Discuss how these different women fit in history (timeline) and how they have impacted the world.
- 6. Ask students to try to identify with these women and what they can learn from them.
