

Budget Overview




SIUE FY22 Budget Sources of Revenue

Total Budget (All Sources) = \$307 Million



- State Appropriation (27%) / Tuition (46%) / Student Fees (14%) / Housing Room & Board (7%) / State Grants & Contracts (6%)
- Federal/Private Grants & Contracts (51%) / Sales of Goods & Services (44%) / Indirect Cost Recovery (5%)

General Operating Budget = \$172 Million

State Appropriation Funding Levels (\$ in Millions)






State Appropriation as a % of General Operating Budget






SIUE 5-Year Enrollment Trends - Undergraduate






SIUE 5-Year Enrollment Trends – Graduate/Professional





Net Tuition Revenue Decrease (\$ in Millions)





Scholarship & Waiver Funding Level Increases (\$ in Millions)







General Operating Budget Cash Reserves (\$ in Millions)





Average Credit Hours Taught by SIUE Faculty








Average Instructional Cost per Credit Hour Increases






Average Class Size Decreasing






Average Class Size & Tuition and Fee Cost Comparison






Percentage of Classes With Fewer Than 20 Students Enrolled






6-Year Graduation Rates






4-Year Graduation Rates






First to Second Year Retention Rates






FTE Employee Staffing Levels






General Operating Budget Deficit (\$ in Millions)






Housing Impact (\$ in Millions)


