

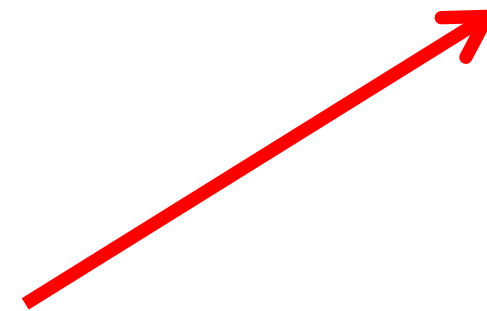

# Implicit Association Test (IAT) – Race IAT

White Americans  
Good

Black Americans  
Bad



We are measuring your reaction times (RTs) to sort words and pictures

# Implicit Association Test (IAT) – Race IAT

White Americans  
Good

Black Americans  
Bad

Beautiful



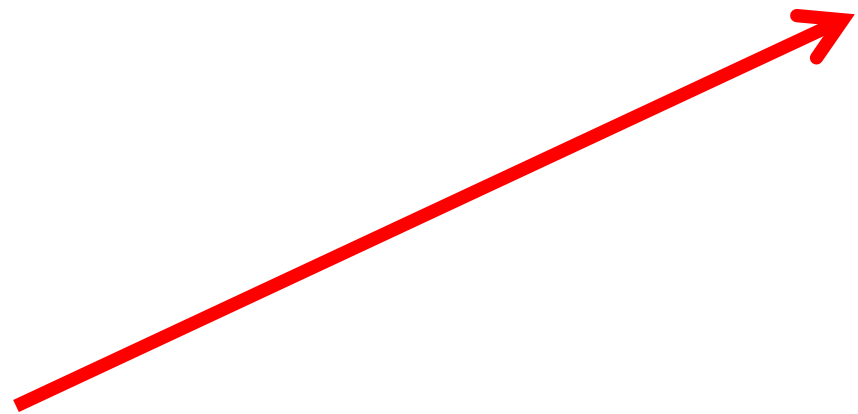
We never ask you to evaluate White people and Black people – just sort!

# Implicit Association Test (IAT) – Race IAT

Black Americans  
Good

White Americans  
Bad

Nasty



Half-way through the IAT, we switch up the categories

# Implicit Association Test (IAT) – Race IAT

Black Americans  
Good

White Americans  
Bad



We compare whether you respond faster to the first or second pairing

# Interpreting your IAT score

<u>Block</u>	<u>Left</u>	<u>Right</u>
1	White American	Black American
2	Good	Bad
3	White or Good	Black or Bad
4	Black American	White American
5	Black or Good	White or Bad

# Interpreting your IAT score

<u>Block</u>	<u>Left</u>	<u>Right</u>
1	White American	Black American
2	Good	Bad
3	White or Good	Black or Bad
4	Black American	White American
5	Black or Good	White or Bad

Implicit preference for  
White over Black =  
faster reaction times to  
Block 3 (White + Good  
and Black + Bad)  
compared to  
Block 5 (Black + Good  
and White + Bad)

# Understanding your IAT score

- How do people score on the Race IAT?



## White people

73% pro-White

16% no preference

11% pro-Black

## Black people

41% pro-White

25% no preference

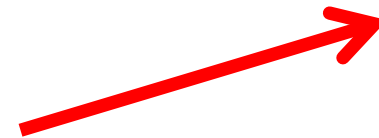
34% pro-Black



# Understanding your IAT score

- How do people score on the Race IAT?
- Does the order that I complete the IAT matter?
  - Yes, but very little, and we control for this in research

<u>Block</u>	<u>Left</u>	<u>Right</u>
1	White American	Black American
2	Good	Bad
3	White or Good	Black or Bad
4	Black American	White American
5	Black or Good	White or Bad



# Understanding your IAT score

Block	Left	Right
1	White American	Black American
2	Good	Bad
3	White or Good	Black or Bad
4	Black American	White American
5	Black or Good	White or Bad

- How do people score on the Race IAT?
- Does the order that I complete the IAT matter?
  - Yes, but very little, and we control for this in research
- Does an implicit preference for White people over Black people or Straight people over Gay people, or XYZ, mean I'm prejudiced?
  - No, the IAT measures implicit bias, which may not align with explicit bias
  - Your feedback IS an important opportunity for reflection and learning
