## **Summarization Steps**

- 1. Read the text in full and make sure you completely *understand* the text.
- 2. Ask yourself:
  - a. How many main ideas are there?
  - b. What are the main ideas?
  - c. Where are the main ideas located?
  - d. What are the primary supporting ideas?
- 3. For each main idea, underline key words that give the main ideas and primary supporting details. Cross out phrases that provide secondary supporting details.
- 4. Write a topic sentence that expresses the main idea (paraphrase this)
- 5. Paraphrase supporting ideas in order to put the information in your own words.
- 6. Review your summary:
  - a. There should be 1-2 sentences for each main idea.
  - b. Check that your summary expresses the same meaning as the original.
  - c. If your summary's words are too similar to the original, paraphrase more using additional strategies and synonyms.
