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



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## An Example: Internships and Co-ops

#### Outcomes

- Valuable experience in chosen field while going to school
- Applies classroom theory to realistic work setting
- Builds upon career readiness competencies
- Assists in the development of a professional network

#### Context

- Employers vetted
- Internship or experiential learning options for every major
- Credit and zero credit; paid and unpaid
  - We advocate for paid
- 2022-2023 SIUE students earned (reported through CDC)
  - Nearly \$2.89 million
  - Hourly average wage of \$20.53

# An Example: ADEI Leadership Certificate

#### **Outcomes, students will:**

- Understand the role of inclusive excellence in organizational structures
- Communicate effectively cross-culturally
- Learn diverse leadership and communication styles
- Understand how to engage in difficult conversations effectively
- Learn how to be effective leaders, allies and advocates
- Build mutually beneficial and respectful relationships

#### Context

- Successful completion of the certificate requires 30 total hours of interdisciplinary engagement and professional development, determined by personal interest
- Students can access anytime throughout college career with flexible pace

- Learn more about yourself through assessments





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
# Step 2: Level Up

- Complete ADEI Leadership Certificate




