• The \$250.00 scholarship is awarded in the Fall Semester

• Applicant must submit 2 letters of recommendation addressing the criteria above (from faculty members, clinical preceptor, community representatives, or work supervisors if applicable)

• Applicant should submit an essay of no more than 300 words, addressing all eligibility criterion below. The essay should focus on these items:

- How the scholarship will assist the applicant in achieving professional goals;
- How the applicant has made efforts to promote diversity or inclusiveness through school, community or other organizational activities.
