The person providing the reference is asked to complete the reference form, sign it, and put it in an envelope (preferably letterhead), sign across the sealed flap, and return it to the student to be sent in the application packet.

The deadline for applications to the DNP program is March 1 for admission to the program starting in the fall. Interviews will be arranged at a later date.

If accepted into the program, you will also be required to provide a completed physical exam/immunization form, proof of current unencumbered RN and Advanced practice licenses, and evidence of current CPR certification. (The required CPR certification may be obtained through completion of the American Heart Association *"Health Care Provider"* course or the American Red Cross *"CPR for the Professional Rescuer"* course.)
