Title: Measurement of Grit Among Pre-Pharmacy Students

Abstract

Objective. To determine Grit-S scores in pre-pharmacy students at SIUE to assess grit in this population of students. Methods. A 13-item electronic survey was administered to pre-pharmacy students. Items addressed in the survey included basic demographic information and Grit-S scores. Results. A total of 36 pre-pharmacy students completed the full survey and a mean grit score was calculated to be 3.74. Additionally, the demographic characteristics the students reported were similar with a distinct exception. Conclusion. The results seem to correlate with other research that has been done evaluating Grit-S scores in students.
