

1st Grade Extended Response Writing Rubric

4 Responds in a complete sentence, restating the question, with the correct answer.
Most sentences are complete sentences.
Maintains focus in writing.
Contains 2 or more supporting details.
Writing is in purposeful order.
Details support the main idea with ideas from the text AND the student's own ideas.

3 Responds in complete sentence, restating the question, with the correct answer.
Most sentences are complete sentences.
Maintains focus in writing.
Contains 1 or 2 supporting details.
Writing is in purposeful order.
Details support the main idea with ideas from the text or from the student's own ideas.

2 Responds in a complete sentence with the correct answer.
Most sentences are complete sentences.
May contain one detail that supports the main idea. Other details may be included but are unrelated.
Writing is somewhat in order, possibly containing a lapse in sequence.

1 Responds to task with correct answer with individual words or clusters of words. (Answer is not in a complete sentence.)

0 Does one of the following:
Does not respond to task. Paper is blank.
Responds with incorrect answer.
Copies text.
